RULES:

1. Construct an item for the Idaho FFA Foundation Auction to be held Friday, April 8, 2011 at the Idaho State FFA Leadership Conference. You may use wood, metal or other materials – use your creativity!
2. Take your item(s) to the CSI Fine Arts Auditorium Lobby at registration by Thursday, April 7 at 5:00 pm.
3. Please be sure the name of the individuals responsible for the item and your Chapter are clearly identified and secured on your item. Identification cards will be provided. Chapters may enter one or two items.
4. The items will be displayed, judged, and then auctioned off on Friday during the morning session with proceeds being used to benefit the work of the Idaho FFA Foundation. All chapters participating will be recognized during the auction, as well as on the Idaho FFA Foundation website and in the Foundation annual report. The judges will be looking for function, creativity and quality. If there are more entries than time allows for the live auction, some items may be sold by silent auction.
5. Judges for the competition will be selected by the IVATA.
