Through the outstanding efforts of FFA Chapters around the state \$23,620 was raised through the 2011 Idaho FFA Foundation Tractor Raffle. \$14,000 of those funds have been designated for Post Secondary Education Scholarships for 2012 Idaho FFA Seniors. The remaining Tractor Raffle funds support other Idaho FFA programs.

Scholarship Rules and Eligibility Requirements:

- Scholarships are available to students enrolling in a post secondary education program at a college, university or technical school.
- Applicant must be currently enrolled as a member of their local FFA Chapter and the Idaho FFA Association, be a current high school senior, and have a minimum 2.5 GPA.
- **Completed application with all required signatures, along with an official transcript of high school record to date, two letters of recommendation, and a recent photo in which the applicant is wearing their FFA jacket must be submitted with a postmark on or before February 15, 2012.** Photo will be used for publicity purposes only and not provided to the scholarship committee.
- Scholarship recipients must enroll as a full-time student at a post-secondary institution within 12 months of graduating to receive the scholarship. (Exceptions to extend this time period for up to 24 months may be granted upon written request to accommodate religious, military, FFA state or national officer commitments.) All scholarship funds will be paid directly to the educational institution after proof of enrollment is received.
- Applicants will receive equal consideration regardless if they are attending an in-state or out-of-state institution, or whether the institution is a university, college or vocational/technical school. Students majoring in all fields of study are also eligible to apply.
